OUR CENTRE

In 2009, the IOM African Capacity Building Centre (ACBC) was established in Moshi, United Republic of Tanzania, to enhance the migration management capacity of officials from African Member States, promote comprehensive migration governance and facilitate a diverse range of migration and border management projects and training courses. The Centre shares its premises with the Tanzania Regional Immigration Training Academy (TRITA), a training institution of the Tanzanian Immigration Department. ACBC is here to:

- Develop and deliver training courses and capacity enhancement for African Member States
- Develop and publish training curricula and source books focusing on addressing migration and border management challenges in Africa
- Provide technical advice and support, in cooperation with IOM Country Offices and IOM's four Regional Offices in Africa (Cairo, Nairobi, Pretoria and Dakar).

ACBC's team of experts is here to respond to an increasingly wide range of requests from African States to build and enhance capacity and help shape innovative solutions in border and migration management.



MAIN FOCUS

ACBC's core activities are outlined by three pillars of assistance:

- Capacity-building in border and migration management
- Migration research and development
- Migration advocacy and partnership



OUR FACILITIES

The ACBC/TRITA facilities include several training rooms (including interpreters' booths in the largest room), a security document lab (for secondary lines of verification), as well as a fully-equipped MIDAS* development and demonstration facility.

The ACBC/TRITA classrooms are air-conditioned and equipped with Wi-Fi and LCD projectors, thereby ensuring outstanding technological support for conferences, workshops and training events. The ACBC/TRITA facilities underwent an extensive renovation in 2014.

ACBC is located in Moshi, United Republic of Tanzania, only a 45-minute drive from Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO) in one of the most enchanting regions of the African continent.
